

Our Whole School Behaviour System : Rewards - Newman Points

Newman Points can be awarded for lots of different reasons and are usually awarded in increments of 1, 3 or 5 points for class work. Points which are awarded for consistency in learning, or that demonstrate learning excellence are usually awarded in increments of 20 – 50 points. Points are accumulated throughout the year and success is celebrated in Year group and whole school assemblies .

Our Whole School Behaviour System : Sanctions

There are occasions when our pupils and students get things wrong, or make poor decisions. We operate a tiered response to instances of unacceptable behaviour, but the guidance below is intended to advise you of the main process. Serious instances of unacceptable behaviour or failure to respond to the tiered response may result in further consequences at the discretion of the Headteacher.

Behaviour That Distracts From Learning C1/H1 Warning	Behaviour That Impacts On Learning C2/H2 1 hour detention	Disruptive, Dangerous, Defiant or Disrespectful Behaviour That Stops Learning
<p>You will receive a warning if you;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Talk and distract others (low level disruption)- Do not follow instructions- Walk around the classroom without permission- Fail to start work promptly- Arrive to lesson without all the required equipment- Arrive with an aspect of incorrect uniform- Arrive late to lesson without a valid reason- Arrive to lesson without required home learning	<p>You will receive a detention if you;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Repeatedly are late to lesson, without a valid reason- Repeat of any C1/H1 behaviour- Are defiant by refusing to follow instructions- Walk out of a lesson without permission- Are not focused once learning has begun- Use inappropriate language/comments to other students or staff- Repeatedly arrive to lesson without having completed required home learning	<p>You will receive an extended detention, issued by Learning Coordinator or SLT for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Repeated instances of behaviour which impacts learning throughout the week- Disruptive, dangerous or defiant behaviour within school *- Removal from lesson*- Truancy from lesson/school*
