

## The Saint John Henry Newman Catholic School 6th form tuition catch up funding statement

As a part of the Government Coronavirus catch up fund The Saint John Henry Newman Catholic School has received a grant of £5530 to provide small group tuition. The funding is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, Maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted. Before allocating this funding The Saint John Henry Newman Catholic School has gone through the following process:

The assessment of need: The students targeted for this provision are pupil premium or vulnerable students from disadvantaged backgrounds who did not achieve a grade 4 in English and Maths at key stage 4. Overall 12 students will benefit from the provision, 9 in Maths and 7 in English, there is some overlap.

Planned delivery: The curriculum is planned to be delivered as a catch up curriculum focusing on the key knowledge that is required for a grade 4 in the English and Maths examinations. Resources have been centrally planned and will be adapted for the relevant groups and individuals.

The tuition provided: The tuition will be provided to the English and Maths for students in the following ways:

- Small group provision and teaching by a trained English or Maths teacher
- Support from a past pupil in small groups of 2-4
- Provision of revision guides and resources

These strategies have already proved successful with students sitting the November resits, the results are below. These compare very favourable to the National pass rates.
